
Sensory Art Making



Paper marbling can be a fun way of mixing colours with unknown results. These can be a striking stand-alone image or used within card making and wrapping paper.

Things you will need:

Paper/card
Shaving foam
Baking tray (a container to hold the shaving foam)
Paints or food colouring
Cocktail stick
Ruler/cardboard strip or old bank card

Instructions:

Step 1

Use shaving foam to create a base for your colours, keep within the containment of your chosen container such as a baking tray.



Step 2

Drop colours directly onto the shaving foam.



Step 3

Using a cocktail stick or any utensil to move the pain through the shaving foam. Try experimenting with different objects and how much mixing is done.



Step 4

Place paper/card on top of foam and gently press.

Step 5

Remove paper/card and scrape shaving foam off the page using a straight object such as a ruler, piece of cardboard or an old bank card. Step 4 can be repeated for different effects.
