

Ride for Life 2022

Terms and Conditions

Please read these terms and conditions carefully and make sure that you understand them before completing your registration. You should understand that by submitting your registration form, you agree to be bound by these Terms for yourself and all those you are registering.

I understand that I take part in this event at my own risk and that East Anglia's Children's Hospices (EACH) & Chapeau Events Ltd will not be liable for any injury (however caused) that may occur as a result of my participation.

3 Day Challenge

- Participants must be 18 years or over on the day of the event
- Places are non-refundable but they can be transferred (see point 7)
- Participants taking part in the 3 day event are asked to raise a target sponsorship of £600 for EACH
- Participants taking part in the one day legs are asked to raise a target sponsorship of £150 for EACH
- You will be capable of cycling 60-85 miles per day.

You acknowledge that:

1. EACH are the organiser of the Event with the full support from Chapeau Events Ltd.
2. Your non – refundable registration fee of £100 is paid to EACH Trading.
3. The full cost of the trip is £400 per person, EACH subsidises the extra £300 to provide you to get sponsorship for the event. Therefore the first £300 of sponsorship is not gift aid able.
4. Participants take part in the Event at their own risk and are solely responsible for their own personal health and safety.
5. Any property participants take with them to the Event shall be their own sole responsibility.
6. EACH & Chapeau Events Ltd reserves the right to take emergency decisions based on adverse conditions at the Event, or to change the Event route or number of participants permitted to take part in the Event, if Chapeau Events Ltd believes it is in the best interests of one or more of the participants to do so.
7. Participants must be aware of the inherent risks involved in the Event, including physical hazards along the route, other participants in the Event, the general public or wildlife, and adverse weather conditions.
8. Cyclists must adhere to the Highway Code at all times and must wear a cycling helmet which meets British standards whilst participating in the event. (Note: you will not be allowed to participate without a helmet)
9. If any cyclist chooses an alternative route or leaves the scheduled route without finishing, they do so at their own risk and neither EACH or Chapeau Events Ltd are responsible. In the case of leaving the route early without finishing the event; we request that you contact the event leader to inform them.
10. Participation in the Event is subject to completing a medical declaration prior to the Event. EACH and Chapeau Events Ltd reserve the right to require written consent from your GP before allowing you to participate in the Event if required.
11. The registration fee for this event is non-refundable. If you are unable to take part due to illness or injury your registration fee can be transferred to another person. This must be done before 27th August 2021.

12. EACH reserves the right to update its terms and conditions in relation to Ride For Life at any time prior to the event. All participants will be provided with any updated terms and conditions in advance of the event.

Disclaimer

EACH and Chapeau Events Ltd shall not be liable for any personal injury you may suffer (including death) as a result of your participation in the Event unless the injury is caused through negligence of EACH or Chapeau Events Ltd employees or volunteers. Neither EACH nor Chapeau Events Ltd shall be liable to you for, any loss or damage to your property during or in connection with the event.

Participants' Responsibilities

1. Participants will supply all equipment that they will need to participate in the Event, including a bicycle, helmet, lights and spare parts (equipment).
2. Participants will ensure that all equipment is in proper working order and fit for its intended purpose and shall take out appropriate insurance cover to the full replacement value of the equipment for the duration of the Event. The insurance must cover the Event and include theft and damage to the bicycle.
3. Participants will wear suitable protective clothing, including a helmet, at all times during the cycling stages of the Event.
4. Participants will keep all critical medical information on them at all times during the Event.
5. Participants will complete the online medical declaration form (part of the Participant Information Form) before the Event.
6. Participants will conduct themselves in a safe and sensible manner whilst participating in the Event and will not intentionally or recklessly endanger the safety of any other person during the Event.
7. Participants will abide by all safety instructions of EACH and Chapeau Events Ltd and agree to act upon the reasonable requests and advice.
8. I agree that medical advice should be sought from my GP if I am in any doubt as to my physical ability to participate in this event.
9. Participants are forbidden to use any illicit or illegal substances, nor drink alcohol, during your participation in the Event.
10. Participants taking part in the 3 day event agree to raise a target sponsorship of £600 for EACH.
11. Participants taking part in the one day legs agree to raise a target sponsorship of £150 for EACH.

Covid

1. Should Ride For Life not go ahead due to the ongoing pandemic, we promise to automatically defer your ticket to the next event.
2. If you are displaying COVID-19 symptoms, you will not be permitted to attend the event. Please email events@each.org.uk to notify us of this.
3. We are working in consultation with Local Authorities, Government advice, Health & Safety Professionals and Industry bodies to ensure that all measures we are taking are suitable and up to date with current guidelines. Because of this, information on social distancing, face masks and specific COVID-19 procedures will be updated over the coming weeks and months. All event information will be emailed to each lead booker (with the email address provided at sign up) and it is the participants responsibility to read this information.

Consent

Participants consent to and permit emergency medical treatment if they suffer illness or injury during the Event, including transportation to a medical facility. They will be responsible for any and all related costs.
