

What can you do to support our hospice appeal?



Add some fun to your life - and some money to Each's funds - at a Colour Dash

Take part in a Colour Dash run, hold a cake sale at work or home, or visit one of Each's shops across Cambridgeshire - these are just three of the many ways you can raise money to support families with a seriously ill child.

The *Cambridge Independent* is campaigning to raise £87,500 to bring the Each Help at Home service to Cambridgeshire.

The aim of Each Help at Home is to link a caring individual to a family whose child has a life-limiting condition, providing practical support such as cooking, driving, cleaning and gardening. The money will provide three years of funding, paying for a volunteer co-ordinator as well as training volunteers.

We are asking our readers to help these families cope with the burden of everyday life. East Anglia's Children's Hospices (Each) relies on voluntary donations to provide its specialist care and support to children, young people and families. That means the charity is very active in the communities it serves, with dedicated fundraising teams and a retail network of 22 shops ensuring its branding is familiar to all.

Each's fundraisers host some of the most popular events on the regional calendar, in a bid to raise more than £5million every year.

The biggest is its Colour Dash fun run series, in which participants are showered with clouds of different-coloured powder paint. Last summer more than 5,300 runners across seven locations took part, raising £150,000. This year, Each is running 5km (3.1-mile) Colour Dash runs in nine locations, including one at King's in Ely on Saturday, August 12.

Lesa Barker, Each's head of regional fundraising, said: "We rely heavily on community and corporate support. There are hundreds of people and organisations who do truly extraordinary things to raise money for us year after year and we couldn't be more grateful.

"As leaders in children's palliative care, it's natural for us to be looking to grow our services, and that's why the support of the *Cambridge Independent* in securing funding for Each Help at Home is vital."

Each needs to raise £2.5m from its shops every year. The charity is looking to expand its retail offering in order to continue meeting and maybe even exceed that target.

In Cambridgeshire, Each has shops in Histon Road, Cambridge and in Whittlesey.

From Thursday, April 13, it will have a third shop at the former Lloyds Bank premises in High Street, Cherry Hinton, to offer the same range of high-quality goods customers of the current shops are used to.

Ian Nicolson, Each head of retail, said: "We're delighted to be coming to Cherry Hinton as we begin plans to increase our presence in high streets across the region by eight shops per year. The plans might seem ambitious, but we're certain they're achievable.

"Cambridgeshire is certainly a county in which we'd like to add outlets. We're particularly looking for big edge-of-town units that we can trade furniture from and use to help us build donations, so if you spot anywhere that might fit the bill, please let us know."
